

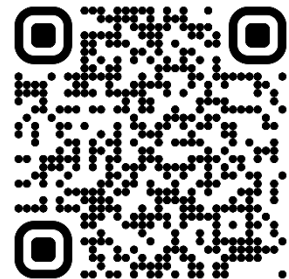
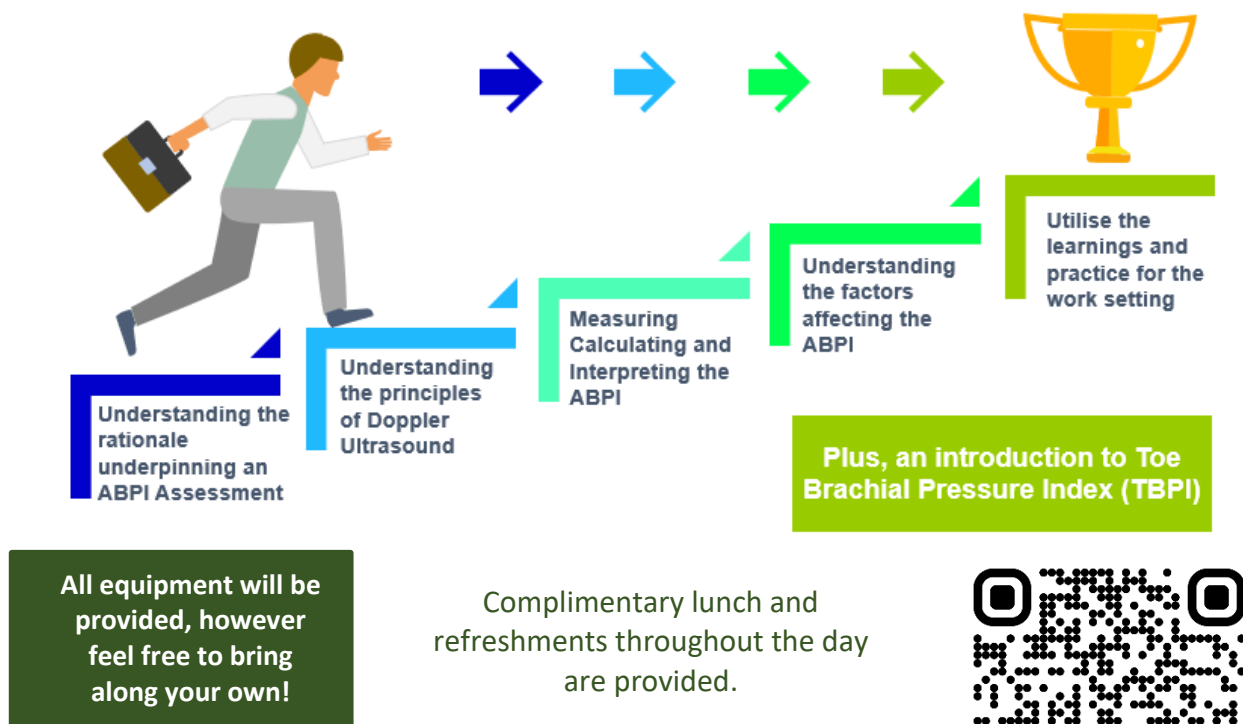
Ankle Brachial Pressure Index (ABPI) Assessment Workshop, Towyn
